Prof. (Dr.) Jayashree Shinde

Professor Jayashree Shinde possessing additional charge of the Dean, Interdisciplinary Studies at the University. She is a professor of Educational Technology and has completed 30 years of service at the 110-year-old SNDT Women's University, Mumbai,

Dr. Shinde is the Director of UGC's Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MMTTC). More than 2500 university and college teachers across the country are trained in the faculty training programmes organized by her.

Areas of her expertise in training, development, and research are Educational Technology, Innovative Learning and Evaluation strategies, constructivist pedagogies, eLearning, Instructional Design, Open and Distance Learning systems, Open Educational Resources, ICT-based training, interactive resource development, etc.

After NEP-2020 was introduced, she worked on 3 National level committees formed by UGC and Ministry of Education for NEP Implementation: Blended Learning, Innovative Pedagogy and National Focus Group of School Education for Educational Technology. She was also co-opted member of the Maharashtra State Committee for the Report on Restructuring of HEIs.

Dr. Shinde has conducted several development and research projects worth a sanctioned amount of a few Crores, including projects in Blended learning and ICT-integration in collaboration with the Commonwealth of Learning, Canada and Ministry.

Dr. Shinde has worked as a resource person in Bangladesh, Mauritius, Singapore, Slovenia and has taught a course at M.Ed. in the Regina University, Canada. She was a Standing Committee member of National Mission for ICT in Education (NMEICT) of the Government of India and ePG Pathshala, UGC. She was on the Advisory Committee of NCERT for MOOCs and is editor of UGC Care-listed Indian Journal of Educational Technology.

She was the co-ordinator of the initiative for launching Technology-Enabled Learning Policy of the SNDT Women's University. She is on the Advisory Board of the "Open Education for Better World" project of UNESCO Slovenia, where she worked as a Mentor and Hub-coordinator of Asia.

Dr. Shinde is a Trustee of QUEST, an NGO with the motivation to pursue quality-related issues in Early Childhood Education, elementary education, and teacher professional development, mainly in rural and Adivasi regions. She is also a Trustee of Narayan Ashram Rural Reconstruction and Education organisation.
