INTRODUCTION

With increasing prevalence of new employment models the corporate research of the 21st century has rapidly evolved in its nature and complexity. The curriculum in the educational institutions needs to be revised on a continuous basis to incorporate this unfolding scenario. There is a need for a better linkage between the changes in the corporate sector and the academic research.

By 2020, 65% of India's population is likely to be under the age of 35. Ideally, the new workforce is required to be much more educated, having high aspirations and well informed about the current market needs. However, the current educational scenario does not appear to be coping with the changes. This has raised the issue of employability of the youth. Their employability is being questioned increasingly.

On the other hand, the uncertainty of employment generation coupled with fast changing industrial structure is giving rise to a different situation of industry-academia relation that throws unseen and unfamiliar challenges before the academic professionals.

The papers to be sent for presentation in the conference and publication afterwards, should analyse the changing dynamics of research in Economics related to the corporate sector and chart a way forward that can tackle the challenges faced by the academic professionals.

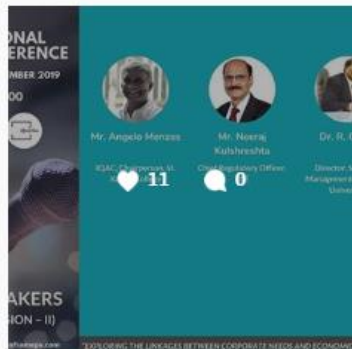
