


The webinar was subdivided into two sessions namely:

- 2. Speaker's Session.




The webinar started with the welcome address given by Dr. SanjayKumar Phad Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, SNDT Womens's University, Mumbai.







After the completion of the inaugural session, we started with the speaker's session. This session was introduced by Prof. Ruby Ohja by briefly introducing all the speakers of the session.


