Minutes of the meeting of Advisory Board (AB) of SUUTI held on February 15, 2022

A meeting of the Advisory Board (AB) of Specified Undertaking of the Unit Trust of India (SUUTI) was held on February 15, 2022 at 2.00 p.m. in the Mini Committee Room, Churchgate Campus, Mumbai 400 020, where the following members were present.

Dr. Mira Desai had sent mail regarding her absence for the SUUTI meeting.

Formal introduction of all members of SUUTI Committee.

Dr. Archana Bhatnagar welcomed all the members and informed the house that the University has added two new members in this Advisory Committee i.e. Dr. Mira Desai and Dr. Manisha Madhava since earlier members Dr. Asha Patil has retired and Dr. Chaitra Redkar has left the University.

Dr. Archana Bhatnagar also introduced our new Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Dr. Ujwala Chakradeo, Pro-Vice Chancellor Dr. Ruby Ojha and Dr. Subhash Waghmare, Registrar (Addl. Charge) and Dr. Manisha Madhava to Ms Anita Patole (Nominee of UTI) .

Brief background about SUUTI Fellowship

Dr A. Bhatnagar gave brief information about SUUTI to the House, when she took charge of the post of OSD, it was observed that there was not a systematic methodology for procedures. Earlier, SUUTI was given financial assistant for only Assistant Professor but later it had decided to give financial assistant not only Assistant Professor but also Associate Professor. SUUTI members framed the norms and brought Uniformity in the application form and also decided that funds given to the researchers will not be more than Rs.40,000/-. The project's time period was one year and funds were to be distributed to the researcher in three parts i.e. first installment is 40%, 2nd installments is 40%. Accordingly, researcher has to submit their progress reports and after submission of final research, and approval of report from Scrutiny committee, the last installment of 20% will be issued to the researcher.

Dr. Ruby Ojha informed the House that University had permitted the researchers to use the Office Equipments, books from library for their SUUTI research. Therefore, in the norms there are no provisions for financial assistant for equipments.

Dr. Archana Bhatnagar stated that under SUUTI, we had given Ph.D. Fellowship / scholarship to the Ph.D. Scholars, for those who did not availed any previous scholarship. For SUUTI fellowship, the University has constituted Scrutiny Committee to scrutinize the project and selected students

who gave presentation. This scholarship is for three years amount of Rs.10,000/- p.m. and Rs.3,60,000/- for three years. She stated that in the last minutes of the meeting i.e. 10.10.2021, it was mentioned that three Ph.D. Scholars have completed their Ph.D. under the SUUTI fellowship successfully.

AGENDA ITEM NO.01

To confirm the minutes of the last meeting held on 10.10.2019.

RESOLUTION:

Resolved that, the minutes of the last meeting of the Advisory Board held on October 10, 2019 be approved.

AGENDA ITEM NO.02

To consider the matter, if any, arising out of the earlier proceedings.

Information / Discussion:-

Members reviewed the last minutes of the meeting dated 10.10.2019. Ms. Anita Patole, Representative of UTI has raised the points that University had used the SUUTI funds for basement construction. SUUTI does not allow to utilize the SUUTI funds for the construction purpose or furniture for basement.

On the above discussion, Dr. Ruby Ojha clarified that University has spent Rs. 65 lacs for renovation of basement and furnishing the rooms but still university is not able to use the basement in spite of renovating because of furniture. University does not have such funds for furniture so on behalf of University requested the UTI to think about it.

Once again Ms. Anita Madam, Representative of UTI, explained that in earlier correspondence it was mentioned that **the main purpose is to giving funds for endowments and this funds should be utilized only for financial help for furthering studies for women's who comes from rural and backward section of the society.**

For expansion of SUUTI funds, Dr. Ruby Ojha has requested to give the fellowship benefit not only to the University Teachers and Students but also to our Conducted and Affiliated Colleges teachers and students. Due to this, many of our teachers and students from affiliated colleges which are situated in rural areas shall be benefited from this SUUTI funds.

On the above discussion, Ms. Anita Madam explained to the House that Associate and Assistant Professors are financially sound and they achieve certain financial status. She informed the house that last year SUUTI funds had given to male teachers but **now onwards it should be given to**

only women students who are economically weaker and funds are required for the student's furthering studies as per the UTI norms or earlier letters.

Dr. Manisha Madahva suggested that students get scholarship from many sources but for research, teachers not get funds in spite of research is an action research activity.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Madam expressed her views that if the SUUTI's aim is to give financial assistant to women students in rural areas so the University has four campuses i.e. Mumbai, Pune, Shriwardhan and Palghar. We can start this activity from our Palghar campus and then Shriwardhan. Dr. Ruby Ojha stated that if we get students from rural areas from 11th & 12th std. which are not our students but they are from economically weaker section so we will give financial help to those students because in future for Higher Education these women students become a part of our University. Ms. Anita Patole Madam agrees to this point instead of focusing in Mumbai & Pune. It is better to focus on Palghar and Shriwardhan, which are rural areas and if University will encourage these students, we will get more students in future from these areas and this is the real aim of SUUTI to give financial assistant to rural women.

In view of the above, Hon'ble Madam Vice Chancellor has informed the house that University has to constitute a committee to study the new norms for utilizing SUUTI funds for scholarship for women's students from economically weaker section for further studies and funds for research and this norm should be approved from Ms. Anita Patole, Representative of UTI.

RESOLUTION:

- 1) Resolved that University has to constitute a committee to frame the new guidelines/norms to distribute the SUUTI funds only for those women students, who did not study because of their financial crisis. Committee shall submit the new guidelines/norms to the Registrar's Office.
- 2) Resolved that University should arrange SUUTI meeting twice a year.
- 3) Resolved to give a schedule copy of financial entries of SUUTI FUNDS.

The Action Taken Report of the Advisory Board (AB) of Specified Undertaking of the Unit Trust of India (SUUTI) meeting held on 10.10.2019 is placed for kind perusal.
