



1. Introduction

The Julius-Maximilians-Universität, Würzburg is one of the oldest universities of Germany and its establishment dates back to 1402. The University has a rich history of academic research and the distinction of 14 Nobel Laureates having done research here. The University has a Professorship for Adult and Continuing Education in Institut für Pädagogik (Institute for Education) which offers graduate, post graduate and Ph.D programmes.

In the recent past, the Institute for Education under the dynamic leadership of Prof. Dr. Regina Egetenmeyer, Director has been actively associating with educational institutions in India to promote internationalism in adult education. Many of the programmes are supported under the DAAD.

In Dec 2017, the Professorship of the Institute for Education invited Prof. Vandana Chakrabarti, Director, Lifelong Learning and Extension, SNDT Women's University, Mumbai and Dr. Anita Priyadarshini, Associate Professor, STRIDE, Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi to teach a Seminar (Course) for its Post Graduate students.

This Report highlights the teaching experiences of Prof. Vandana Chakrabarti and Dr. Anita Priyadarshini during this Visiting Professorship at JM University.

2. The Seminar(Course): Transformation through Flexible Learning System- An Indian Experience

Prof. Vandana Chakrabarti and Dr. Anita Priyadarshini designed, developed and taught a course entitled 'Transformation through Flexible Learning System - An Indian Experience'. This topic of the Seminar was decided after a great deal of discussion, study and reflection by the Visiting Professors. The course was also aimed at fulfilling the request of Prof. Regina who desired that post graduate students should have an exposure to philosophies and movements of adult education in other countries. It was felt that the students of the Institute would benefit from the rich experiences of India in the areas of adult education and flexible learning. The seminar was jointly conducted for students of the Masters' level of the Institut fur Pädagogik, J.M.University, Wurzburg. The total duration of the seminar was 30 hours and was conducted between December 2 to 22, 2017 at the Bibliotheks-und Seminarzentrum, Room 00.212 (Seminar Room, Room 212), University of Wurzburg.

We are pleased to inform you that you have beer, awarded the <u>Asi it 'n Society's</u> (Social Science) Junior Research Feilowsnip for your research Project on "<u>Cultural Study (f Nomadic Devotee Tribe –</u> <u>Peddamavandlu (Potraj) through their Painted Wooden Shrines and Rituals</u>". The tenure of the Fellowship is for One year from <u>1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019</u>.

It should be of the standard of a research paper acceptable for publication in a refereed journal. The dissertation will be sent to an expert in the field for evaluation. At the end of the year, you are also expected to give an article based on your project.

If the research project is abandoned during the grant period, the Society will recover the Fellowship amount awarded to you.

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Tagore Literacy Award 2018 Professor Vandana Chakrabarti

The Indian Adult Education Association instituted Tagore Literacy Award in 1987 to commemorate the 125th Birth anniversary of the great poet Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore and is given annually to individuals/institutions for their outstanding contribution towards promotion and development of literacy among women.

The award for the year 2018 is being presented to Professor Vandana Chakrabarti, Director, Lifelong Learning and Extension, SNDT Women's University (SNDTWU), Mumbai for her outstanding contribution to teaching, research and extension in adult and continuing education.

Born on January 25, 1959, Professor Vandana Chakrabarti completed her school education from Kolkata. She studied for Bachelor's Degree in Psychology in the University of Kerala. She took both Masters' and Ph.D. in Social Work from the Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai. A gold medalist from University of Kerala, Prof. Vandana was a recipient of National Merit Scholarship for M.A. and UGC fellowship for Ph.D. She was also a topper in the PG Diploma in Education Management which she completed from SNDTWU.

Professor Vandana joined as Director, Department of Continuing and Adult Education & Extension Work in SNDTWU in 1993 and spent a major part of her career in this position. She also worked as Director, Board of Colleges and University Development in SNDTWU for some time. She was a Pro Vice Chancellor of this University for five years from June 2011 to May 2016. Before joining SNDTWU she taught Social Work in Bishop Heber College, Cauvery College for Women and then in Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirapalli.

As a Director, she initiated a large number of community based courses and training programmes and fortified the network with other departments, colleges and NGOs with whose collaboration the academic resources of the University were used to strengthen the masses. Under her stewardship continuing education opportunities were offered to those already in employment across a large number of occupations and wished to acquire advanced skills with certification. Skill based diploma and certificate courses were also offered to those who wished for a change of career or to enter new occupations. During her directorship the department got NLM-UNESCO Award in the year 2002 in appreciation of the excellent work done in the field of continuing education.

Professor Vandana has been instrumental in initiating Master's Programme in Non-Formal Education and Development to provide professional manpower in the area of adult education. She has marshaled the development of e-content for Masters' programme in Adult Education and sought expertise from academicians and expert practitioners from all over the country to produce high quality learning material which is uploaded on UGC website. A Fulbright Fellow and a scholar of repute, Professor Vandana was invited to teach a short course in Julius Maximilian University, Wurzburg, Germany in December 2017.

Professor Vandana has assisted in numerous ways strengthening government policy and programmes by contributing in many committees, preparing draft documents, reviewing flagship schemes and evaluating programmes, providing professional guidance to different universities and NGOs for improving programme planning and implementation.

Professor Vandana has aligned herself with this very important national cause of adult education and has assisted the government in innumerable ways. Her commitment to the field of adult literacy spreads from field outreach programmes at the grassroots to initiating post-graduate programme in the University for strengthening the discipline of adult and non-formal education to contribution to policy and practice.

The Indian Adult Education Association acknowledges the excellent contribution made by Professor Vandana Chakrabarti in the field of adult education, especially for women and feels privileged to present her the Tagore Literacy Award for the year 2018.




