- > Psychological testing and Logical reasoning will also be included in the test
- > On the spot performance either(Dramatics, Music, Debate etc.)

- General appearance, confidence and poise, sense of grooming, modulation of speech/vocabulary, smartness, etiquette system of overall personality will be considered for marking.
- > Simple grooming, sarees and kurtasalwar are preferable.
