1. An eminent scholar in the field of special Education/rehabilitation of persons with disability having a Ph.D. degree in any discipline of rehabilitation of PWD(s) and published work in Special Education of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC/RCI listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix-II.
2. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions working for persons with disabilities with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

Note:-

A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed to the candidate at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy Layer) / Differently-abled (a) Blind and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf, blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.

A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991 with proper certification.

A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
